

### DISCONTINUANCE IN EXISTING SCHEME/ RE ADMISSION IN A NEW SCHEME

The Department revises Scheme of study every 3 to 5 years. Due to discontinuance/re-admission, some of the students cannot complete studies in the very same scheme in which they joined the course. Such students should obtain permission to change over “Scheme” from the Directorate of Technical Education. After re-joining the course in the new Scheme they should apply to this office through the Principal for new Register Number to appear for the exams under the new Scheme in which they are re-admitted. This is to be done immediately after the re-admission, with a copy of the order of DTE. Such students should appear for examinations under the new Scheme in the new Register Number and failed subjects of previous year/semesters in the old Register Number itself. They should pass the additional subjects, if any, in the context of Scheme change using the new Reg. No. Only after passing all the subjects under both schemes plus the additional subjects, such students become eligible to award diploma certificate.. (See **Government orders** in the site for details of Additional subjects) There is no Internal mark for Additional subject. So those who appear for Additional subject should secure total minimum pass mark in the WRITTEN EXAMINATION itself. That is, they should secure 40% of the total Maximum marks of the subject concerned.
