

DISCONTINUED EXAMINATION/NON EXISTING SCHEME

Sufficient chances are given to the students of each vanishing Scheme to complete the course when a new Scheme is introduced. Such students will be informed of the year and month of the last chance for appearing the examination in their own Scheme which is vanishing. Only the Government can sanction conduct of further examination after the last chance. Even after the last chance, including 'clearance chance', if any of the students are left without completing the course, the only alternate for such remaining students are to complete their course by attending the equivalent subjects in the newly introduced scheme in the place of failed subjects under previous scheme. This facility depends on the availability of equivalent subjects and hence not mandatory. The Curriculum Development Centre, Kalamassery, after consultation with Subject Experts will fix the equivalency which will be communicated, which will be communicated, to the Director of Technical Education, Trivandrum who in turn will forward the same to the Principals of Polytechnic Colleges after obtaining approval from Government. (See **Government orders** in the site for details of Equivalent subjects) Those who appear for the Equivalent subject will be awarded Internal marks proportionate to the Internal marks secured in the corresponding subject under the previous Scheme.
