ORDER

The University of Kerala as per the orders read as 1st paper above has ordered that the deaf and dumb candidates will be given additionally 25% of the marks secured by them in theory papers in all examinations including professional examinations conducted by the University of Kerala since such candidates are backward in linguistic ability. The Secretary, All Kerala parents Association of Hearing Impaired has requested to extend the additional concessions provided by the University of Kerala to the hearing impaired candidates appearing for the University Examinations, to all those hearing impaired candidates appearing for all the examinations including Diploma Examinations conducted by the Controller of Technical Examinations.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that the deaf and dumb candidates appearing for all the examinations conducted by the Controller of Technical Examinations as appended to this order will be given additional 25% of the marks secured by them in the theory papers, on production of Medical Certificate issued by a competent authority in Government service to all those hearing impaired candidates appearing for the examinations.
