

MALPRACTICE – PROCEDURES

The Principals of Polytechnics will report the malpractice cases (of both Theory and practical exams) to this office in the prescribed forms along with Answer script and materials used for the malpractice. Normally the decision on the reported case will be taken before the commencement of the next semester exams. If prima face malpractice is confirmed beyond doubt in the light of the documents and the report, immediate disciplinary step will be taken. Explanation of the candidates will be obtained in necessary cases. If the explanation is not satisfactory or if the candidate does not furnish his reply, decision will be taken based on the reports and material proof available. An enquiry will be conducted by the Joint Controller if it is seen essential. Based on the findings in the enquiry and the explanations received and also on other reports and materials received, a suitable final remedial action will be taken. In exceptional cases the candidate will be given an opportunity for personal hearing. Punishment includes cancelling all the current exams and debarring from attending further examination for certain period. The decision of the Board of Technical Examination with regard to the punishment on malpractice will be final.
